



Use of Hall & Grounds for Dog Shows

As a condition of allowing use of the premises for dog shows we need to make you aware of some issues that have been brought to our attention by the Environmental Health Officer for this area. Following his inspection, he has reported a number of points which, in his view, could constitute a health hazard, especially in areas used by local children and has specified the following recommendations.

1. The floor area used for showing must be covered for the duration of the hire.
2. Tables used for grooming and showing must be covered for the duration of the hire. Please bear in mind that other hirers eat off of these tables and children play at them.
3. Dogs must not be allowed to foul the Hall, the Car Park or the grassed areas surrounding the Hall and adjacent buildings.
4. Any 'accidents' must be thoroughly cleaned up and the floor mopped immediately. Dog waste must not be placed into any of the bins and should be taken away with you and disposed of appropriately.
5. The Hall floor **MUST** be thoroughly swept and mopped at the end of the hire period. If any obvious dog hairs are found after the period of hire, then the deposit will be retained.

We know, of course, that most of our regular users participating in dog showing already comply with these standards but consider it only fair to communicate these points with all hirers.

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
